### Our goal:

Mission-Net has been commissioned by the Evangelical Alliances and Evangelical Missionary Alliances of Europe. The network has been formed to promote, develop and sustain national missions networks in Europe. The group has also commissioned bi-annual large missions events aimed at attracting people aged between 16-30 years old. The first of these took place in Oldenburg, Germany from 8-13 April 2009. ## Jobs within the departments / Still missing

(three categories of leadership in Mission-Net: Director, Coordinator, Organiser)

### 1. Programme Department

#### Coordinator Non-Plenary Events (8hrs/week)

Everything besides the plenary meetings is looked after by this coordinator. This includes seminars and workshops, sport activities, outreaches into the city, late night concerts, national meetings and national stands (Global Village).

*Organiser Sports (about 30hrs in 2011)*

*Organiser Translation (about 60hours in 2011)*

*Organiser Childcare (about 100hours in 2011)*

*Organiser Offering (about 30hours in 2011)*

#### Coordinator Prayer

This coordinator has three teams to coordinate: One team organises the prayer zone where people can pray during the day, another team is responsible for intercession during the conference and another team offers to pray for people on site. The 24/7 movement will be supporting.

## 2. Logistics Department

**The following positions are leadership positions in the Logistics Department during the congress. Team leaders and Location Managers should arrive on Dec.26th and stay until the site is cleared on Jan 2nd evening. Part of the job is to lead a team (maintaining the spiritual and physical wellbeing of team members, making of shift plans and overseeing the smooth running of operations in their area of responsibility.) They are directly reporting to the Site Manager/Director of Logistics**

### Team Leader Café

Creating an environment where participants can relax, enjoy a drink etc. on two or more locations on the site. Sales experience and supply management

### Team Leader Fun Food

The team provides snacks, (fries, popcorn etc.) especially in the evenings  
Purchasing supplies, preparing and setting up the sales points

### Location Manager: - 15 Positions

Location Managers are responsible for a certain location on the site. They coordinate all activities in their respective area with people from programme and logistics.

## 3. Financial Development Department

### **Director of Finances (5-7h/week)**

- Developing an effective financial strategy to fully resource the event and network
- Identifying potential sources of income in the private and public sector and writing proposals to release finances
- Developing the websites online giving module
- Working together with the Marketing Director and National Motivators to publicise giving opportunities
- Develop a sponsoring concept

### Coordinator Sponsoring (5h/week)

This coordinator is responsible for cutting deals with organisations like mission agencies so that there is a win/win situation for everyone included. They will pay for certain advertisement and through that help Mission-Net. This person needs to communicate well.
